The **Tabora Municipal Council** has received funds from the Government of United Republic of Tanzania through World Bank for Urban Local Governments Strengthening Program (ULGSP) towards the cost of Upgrading of 5.32 km Roads to Bitumen Standard under ULGSP in Tabora Municipality and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of the funds to cover eligible payments under the contract.
2. The **Tabora Municipal Council** now invites sealed Tenders from eligible contractors registered or capable of being registered in **Class I** for carrying out the Upgrading of 5.32 km Roads to Bitumen Standard under ULGSP in Tabora Municipality. The works involves the following:


